

**APPLICATION FOR MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE
THROUGH THE CHEROKEE NATION DISTRICT COURT**

A couple wishing to obtain and record a marriage certificate through the Cherokee Nation must present this completed application to the District Court Clerk's office. Couples must be married within the Cherokee Nation jurisdiction with their marriage vows solemnized by a Minister, Spiritual leader, or Justice/Judge of the Cherokee Nation **who has a license to perform marriage issued by the Cherokee Nation Court Clerk.***

Couples applying for a marriage certificate are to both appear in person at the court clerk's office with the following items:

- Picture ID for both
- Proof of Cherokee citizenry from at least one of the parties

A \$10.00 filing fee is due upon presentation of the issued marriage certificate for recording.

A notice will then be posted in a public place for 30 days after which should there be no objections filed, a license to marry will be issued to the applicant.
